Special note: As we begin this year, we offer a note of appreciation to all of our parents for their patience and courage regarding the COVID 19 challenge to almost everything we do. School life has been impacted in many ways: we do not foresee organized sports tournaments such as the annual soccer tournament or the Terry Fox Run happening, nor do we see Music Makers or the annual debating competition happening. Take heart however, we will be having a music teacher assist our staff with music this year, by video conference if necessary, and we will have students involved in morning announcements (by video) and a student council. No doubt we will find more activities that we can do safely as we make our way through the school year. Once again, your patience and cooperation with OES is appreciated from new student drop-off/pick-up routines to safe school (social distancing) requirements.

A note about water: we encourage parents to send their children to school with at least two bottles of water. To make sure we have adequate access to water we have two supply stations that are sanitized regularly and students are taught how to respect safe practices for getting water from the stations.

Visiting the school: A friendly reminder that we will have parents in the school by appointments only – we will also offer video conferencing to reduce the number of people entering the building. However, forgotten lunches and other items can be dropped off in the main entrance. Unfortunately, locker visits to verify clothes and other needs are restricted to staff helping parents as required.

Helpful reminders for children:

- Use hand sanitizer each time you exit and enter the school
- Wash your hands frequently
- Play only with your class group outside keep the bubble
- Grade 5 and 6 students must wear masks in common areas: Hallway, bathrooms, entry/exit and on the bus
- Do NOT share lunch items or water bottles.

Potential re-confinement (aka emergency shutdown): should the provincial government declare another "shut down" due to COVID 19, parents will be informed immediately and the OES staff will follow a pre-established internal protocol for distributing materials to parents and guiding them with the next steps. Rest assured, we have a plan that will maintain contact between your child and the school/teacher and we have a process for on-line learning and assessment.

Annual General Assembly for Parents

1 Elections for Parent Representatives to Governing Board

On Thursday, September 17th at 5:30 p.m., parents are invited to assemble in our new tent (gym if rain) to elect representatives to the school's Governing Board from among the parents in attendance. The Governing Board is comprised of parents, teachers, support staff, the principal and community representatives. Parent members serve for two consecutive years. The purpose of the Governing Board is to provide advice and help make decisions about the aims and objectives for the school and to monitor how these are being achieved. This includes voting on policies and overseeing the implementation of the Educational Project, fundraisers, Code of Conduct, budget, school fees, school trips and other important items. Meetings usually take place one evening per month. If you are interested in becoming part of this organization, please ensure that you attend the Annual General Assembly. All parents present will be able to nominate themselves or another parent, and then vote for the candidates of their choice to fill two vacant positions that are up for election this year. Please see the standard template for AGA attached.

2 Elections for a Representative to Parent Committee (part of AGA)

Once governing board parent representatives are elected, all parents attending the AGA will elect one representative and one alternate to the school board's Parent Committee from among the parent reps on governing board. Parents can express interest in serving on the parent committee, up to and including the date of 19 September. Parents are welcome to contact Ralph Mason (rmason@wqsb.qc.ca) to express their interest in serving on the Parent Committee.

3 Special Education Advisory Committee (part of AGM)

Parents who wish to take part in the school board's Special Education Advisory Committee (S.E.A.C.) will also have an opportunity to submit their names for consideration. Interested parents must have a child with an Individual Education Plan (I.E.P.). Selection of parents for this committee will be made later by the school board's Parent Committee. A sitting member of Governing Board is ideal but not necessary for SEAC representation. Please contact the principal for the official form to make an application to become a member of SEAC.

Appointment of SEAC Members by Parent Committee

The parent members of SEAC are designated by <u>The Parent Committee</u> at the first meeting of the school year. (Typically in October)
