Did you know that you can find books about how to draw animals? Here is an example to try.

- 1) Draw a large petal shape.
- 2) a petal-shaped head and 2 back flippers
- 3) Draw two front flippers
- 4) Add a large hexagon on the shell, and a small hexagon inside the large hexagon
- 5) add an eye and a mouth, spots on the flippers, and lots of lines on the shell! What did your final product look like?
